<u>Please</u> follow the Trash and Recycle rules listed below and make sure the doors on the dumpsters are latched. Please print and post this page in your unit and inform renters and guests of the rules. The Trash and Recycle area is located across from Management Office.

Trash Rules

All trash MUST be put INSIDE the dumpster. There are many animals in the area, especially bears, and trash left on the ground will attract them creating both a mess and a hazard.

Furniture, including mattresses, televisions, treadmills, deck furniture and construction debris must not be left in the dumpster area. If it is not something that you can throw away, you must bring it to the town landfill or arrange to have it picked up.

After you place your trash in the dumpster, please latch the door. The bears can open the sliding door if you don't latch it.

Dump stickers are available with proof of residency. Bring a tax or electric bill with you.
