TRASH & RECYCLE RULES 2018

Please follow the Trash and Recycle rules listed below and make sure the doors on the dumpsters are latched. Please print and post this page in your unit and inform renters and guests of the rules. The Trash and Recycle area is located across from Management Office.

Trash Rules

All trash **MUST** be put **INSIDE** the dumpster. There are many animals in the area, especially bears, and trash left on the ground will attract them creating both a mess and a hazard. Furniture, including mattresses, televisions, treadmills, deck furniture and construction debris must not be left in the dumpster area. If it is not something that you can throw away, you must bring it to the town landfill or arrange to have it picked up.

After you place your trash in the dumpster, please latch the door. The bears can open the sliding door if you don't latch it.

Recycling Rules

What Can Be Recycled

Single Stream Recycling allows all recycled items to be mixed together in the same dumpster. Deposit the following items in the YELLOW dumpster:

Flattened Cardboard	cracker boxes)
Magazines	Aluminum Cans
Office Paper and Junk Mail	Tin and Steel Cans Paper and Cardboard
Brown Paper Bags	Dairy and Juice Containers
Plastic Bottles and Containers #1-7	Phone Books
Paperboard (e.g.	Newspapers
	Glass Bottles and Jars

What Cannot Be Recycled

These items should be placed in the green dumpster:

Food Waste
 Films and Plastic Wrap
Plastic Bags
 Foam Cups and Containers

Plastic bags cannot be recycled, so please put them in as loose items or in brown paper bags.

Town Solid Waste Facility

You can bring large items that will not fit in the dumpster to the town Solid Waste Facility, which is located on Recycle Road behind the McDonalds Restaurant.

Dump stickers are available with proof of residency. Bring a tax or electric bill with you.

The hours of operations are:
 Friday – Tuesday: 8:00 am – 4:30 pm
 Thursday: 8:00 am – 1:00 pm
 Wednesday & all holidays: Closed
